The following is a summary of the actions taken at the December 7, 2021 meeting. An audio copy of the proceedings can be obtained by contacting the District Manager.

FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS Roll Call

Mr. Oliver called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. and called the roll.

SECOND ORDER OF BUSINESS Audience Comments

There being none, the next item followed.

THIRD ORDER OF BUSINESS Approval of the Minutes of the November 2, 2021 Meeting

On MOTION by Mr. Payton seconded by Mr. Randy Smith with all in favor the minutes of the November 2, 2021 meeting were approved as presented.

FOURTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Update Regarding Open Items

A. Phase 5 Construction

Mr. Biagetti stated Dream Finders is still working on the entry monument permit submittal; last time they were working on the site plans to submit that for permitting. It looks like they jumped ship from Signarama it seems they had some issues to swap out the stop sign posts and street signs to match what we currently have. They are saying it should be around the first of the year. They are nearing the second lift of asphalt and they reached out to Clay County to schedule a walk and once they get approval they can get the second lift, which they believe will be done in the first quarter of 2022.

There was a question at the last meeting about the sidewalk on Royal Pines going over the hump and that was completed with the home build.

B. Crosswalk Project

Mr. Payton stated there are not any crosswalks throughout the neighborhood other than golf cart crossings. We have been working with the county for a couple of years trying to get them to fund the project. We finally got them to agree to meet us in the middle and they gave us some signs and posts.

Mr. Payton reviewed the proposals received for painting the golf cart crossings and pedestrian crosswalks and the board took the following action.

On MOTION by Mr. Payton seconded by Mr. Randy Smith with all in favor the quote from M&J for standard paint for pedestrian crosswalks and thermal painting for the golf cart crossings in the amount of \$3,805.60 was approved.

C. Playground Equipment

Mr. Biagetti stated we ordered additional benches, a picnic table, waste receptacles for this playground site and that has been delivered to us. We have the product and we need to assemble and install it and we will do that in-house. The tube slide should be shipped by the end of this week. Southern Recreation is hoping to have it installed by Christmas.

D. Golf Cart Parking

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Mr. Biagetti stated we are scheduled for this weekend to have the striping laid out and the directional signage then we will look at the locations for the removable bollards, which we will do in-house as well.

FIFTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Ratification of Agreement with MacCurrach for Concrete Pad, Curbing and Driving Range Work Including Sod

On MOTION by Mr. Payton seconded by Mr. Randy Smith with all in favor the agreement with MacCurrach was ratified.

SIXTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Ratification of Agreement with Turf Hound Proposal for Artificial Turf

Mr. Oliver stated this Proposal has been approved by the board, the agreement is not yet ready for execution and we will have that at the next meeting.

SEVENTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Ratification of Second Addendum with Viewpoint Security

On MOTION by Mr. Payton seconded by Mr. Randy Smith with all in favor the second addendum with Viewpoint Security was ratified.

EIGHTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Ratification of Change Orders to Installation of Awning

Mr. Biagetti stated there was much more damage to the balconies than expected and it went over the amount in the original quote to make the repair. We are in a much better position moving forward to prevent future sagging and issues with the stucco. There is a change order for each balcony.

On MOTION by Mr. Payton seconded by Mr. Randy Smith with all in favor both change orders with FCC in the amount of \$5,300 and \$6,800 were ratified.

NINTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Staff Reports

- A. General Manager
 - 1. Report

Mr. Hahn gave an overview of the operations report, copy of which was included as part of the agenda package and reviewed the updated capital budget from Honours.

2. Consideration of Water Management Agreement with The Lake Doctors for Triploid Grass Carp Stocking

On MOTION by Mr. Payton seconded by Mr. Randy Smith with all in favor the agreement with The Lake Doctors, Inc. in the amount of \$3,295 was approved.

B. District Counsel

1. Publication of Legal Notices

Ms. Buchanan stated legislation passed that allows for online publications, but the reality is that before you can do the online noticing you have to publish notice in the paper and that potentially removes any cost savings.

2. Needs Analysis that Districts Providing Wastewater or Stormwater Management Services Must Complete by June 30, 2022

Ms. Buchanan stated this is a requirement that was put in place by the legislature and adopted by the governor at the end of the summer. The state issued guidelines on having a needs analysis prepared in September and October. The district engineer is probably going to need to put together a work authorization to perform a review of your stormwater management system and address the bullets that are included on page 2 of 2 that describes what the needs analysis is supposed to include. This is required to be completed by June 30th and I suggest that we ask Alex to bring back a proposal in January.

3. Prompt Payment Requirements

Ms. Buchanan stated next is a prompt payment policy, which you have previously adopted and is redlined to indicate our proposed changes to the policy. Essentially the statute requires that there be an additional procedure and it incorporates a 2% interest rate as compared to the 1% interest rate that was previously approved. We can authorize these changes today and bring back a clean version of your prompt payment policy for you to approve at your next board meeting.

On MOTION by Mr. Payton seconded by Mr. Brink with all in favor the proposed changes were approved and staff will bring back to the next meeting a clean version to be approved by the board.

4. Public Records Exemptions for Addresses and Other Information Associates with Certain Officers, Judges, etc.

Ms. Buchanan stated unless there are questions, I will let you review this one on your own.

The following items were brought up and discussed with staff: How the contractor is working on the awning and expected completion date, signs and posts received from the county, small percentage of emails from staff being opened by residents, issues with locks on gates by the tennis courts and dog park, features of and replace cost of credit card machines, delivery of doors and hinges, replacement of windows, contacted the sheriff's office about a resident using a BB gun, attorney to draft a letter to the homeowner notifying them that the household has been suspended from the amenities and from being on the golf course for one year, request for reports be copied to the supervisors when incidents happen.

Items brought up and discussed with the board and staff: Carp in new pond but two ponds by #5 probably need carp, Orange Park County Club may reopen in the next year to two years and take that into consideration in your long-term planning, need new amps and boxes in surround sound system, bunker maintenance.

RESOLUTION 2022-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE SOUTH VILLAGE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT ADOPTING PROMPT PAYMENT POLICIES AND PROCEDURES PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 218, FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the South Village Community Development District (the "District") is a local unit of special-purpose government created and existing pursuant to Chapter 190, *Florida Statutes*, being situated entirely within Clay County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 218, *Florida Statutes*, requires timely payment to vendors and contractors providing certain goods and/or services to the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the District ("Board") accordingly finds that it is in the best interest of the District to establish by resolution Prompt Payment Policies and Procedures as may be amended or updated from time to time for immediate use and application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE SOUTH VILLAGE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT:

- SECTION 1. The Prompt Payment Policies and Procedures attached hereto as Exhibit A are hereby adopted pursuant to this Resolution as necessary for the conduct of District business. The Prompt Payment Policies and Procedures shall remain in full force and effect until such time as the Board may amend or replace them; provided, however, that as the provisions of Chapter 218, Florida Statutes, are amended from time to time, the attached Prompt Payment Policies and Procedures shall automatically be amended to incorporate the new requirements of law without any further action by the Board. The Prompt Payment Policies and Procedures hereby adopted supplant and replace any previously adopted Prompt Payment Policies and Procedures.
- **SECTION 2.** If any provision of this Resolution is held to be illegal or invalid, the other provisions shall remain in full force and effect.
- **SECTION 3.** This Resolution shall become effective upon its passage and shall remain in effect unless rescinded or repealed.

Prompt Payment Policies and Procedures

In Accordance with the Local Government Prompt Payment Act Chapter 218, Part VII, Florida Statutes

January 4, 2022

South Village Community Development District Prompt Payment Policies and Procedures

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I. Purpose

In accordance with the Local Government Prompt Payment Act (Chapter 218, Part VII, Florida Statutes) ("PPA"), the purpose of the South Village Community Development District ("District") Prompt Payment Policies and Procedures ("Policies & Procedures") is to provide a specific policy to ensure timely payment to Vendors and Contractors (both hereinafter defined) providing goods and/or services to the District and ensure the timely receipt by the District of goods and/or services contemplated at the time of contracting. Please note that the PPA, like any statute or law, may be amended from time to time by legislative action. These Policies & Procedures are based on the statutory requirements as of the date identified on the cover page of this document. By this reference, as applicable statutory provisions subsequently change, these Policies & Procedures shall automatically be amended to incorporate the new requirements of law. These Policies & Procedures are adopted by the District to provide guidance in contracting matters. Failure by the District to comply with these Policies & Procedures shall not expand the rights or remedies of any Provider (hereinafter defined) against the District under the PPA. Nothing contained herein shall be interpreted as more restrictive on the District than what is provided for in the PPA.

II. Scope

These Policies & Procedures apply to all operations of the District, including Construction Services and Non-Construction Goods and Services, as applicable.

III. Definitions

A. Agent

The District-contracted architect, District-contracted engineer, District Manager, or other person, acting on behalf of the District, which is required by law or contract to review invoices or payment requests from Providers (hereinafter defined). Such individuals/entities must be identified in accordance with §218.735 (1), Fla. Stat., and further identified in the relevant agreement between the District and the Provider.

B. Construction Services

All labor, services, and materials provided in connection with the construction, alteration, repair, demolition, reconstruction, or other improvement to real property that require a license under parts I and II of Chapter 489, Fla. Stat.

C. Contractor or Provider of Construction Services

The entity or individual that provides Construction Services through direct contract with the District.

D. Date Stamped

Each original and revised invoice or payment request received by the District shall be marked electronically or manually, by use of a date stamp or other method, which date marking clearly indicates the date such invoice or payment request is first delivered to the District through its Agent. In the event that the Agent receives an invoice or payment request, but fails to timely or physically mark on the document the date received, "Date Stamped" shall mean the date of actual receipt by the Agent.

E. Improper Invoice

An invoice that does not conform to the requirements of a Proper Invoice.

F. Improper Payment Request

A request for payment for Construction Services that does not conform to the requirements of a Proper Payment Request.

G. Non-Construction Goods and Services

All labor, services, goods and materials provided in connection with anything other than construction, alteration, repair, demolition, reconstruction, or other improvements to real property.

H. Proper Invoice

An invoice that conforms to all statutory requirements, all requirements of these Policies and Procedures not expressly waived by the District and any additional requirements included in the agreement for goods and/or services for which the invoice is submitted not expressly waived by the District.

I. Proper Payment Request

A request for payment for Construction Services which conforms to all statutory requirements, all requirements of these Policies & Procedures not expressly waived by the District and any additional requirements included in the Construction Services agreement for which the Payment Request is submitted not expressly waived by the District.

J. Provider

Includes any Vendor, Contractor or Provider of Construction Services, as defined herein.

K. Purchase

The purchase of goods, materials, services, or Construction Services; the purchase or lease of personal property; or the lease of real property by the District.

L. Vendor

Any person or entity that sells goods or services, sells or leases personal property, or leases real property directly to the District, not including Construction Services.

IV. Proper Invoice/Payment Request Requirements

A. General

Prior to Provider receiving payment from the District, Non-Construction Goods and Services and Construction Services, as applicable, shall be received and performed in accordance with contractual or other specifications or requirements to the satisfaction of the District. Provision or delivery of Non-Construction Goods and Services to the District does not constitute acceptance for the purpose of payment. Final acceptance and authorization of payment shall be made only after delivery and inspection by the Agent and the Agent's confirmation that the Non-Construction Goods and Services or Construction Services meet contract specifications and conditions. Should the Non-Construction Goods and Services or Construction Services differ in any respect from the specifications, payment may be withheld until such time as the Provider takes necessary corrective action. Certain limited exceptions which require payment in advance are permitted when authorized by the District Board of Supervisors ("Board") or when provided for in the applicable agreement.

B. Sales Tax

Providers should not include sales tax on any invoice or payment request. The District's current tax-exempt number is ______. A copy of the tax-exempt form will be supplied to Providers upon request.

C. Federal Identification and Social Security Numbers

Providers are paid using either a Federal Identification Number or Social Security Number. To receive payment, Providers should supply the District with the correct number as well as a proper Internal Revenue Service W-9 Form. The District Manager shall treat information provided in accordance with Florida law.

Providers should notify the District Manager when changes in data occur (telephone (904) 940-5850, email mgiles@gmsnf.com).

D. Proper Invoice for Non-Construction Goods and Services

All Non-Construction Goods and Services invoiced must be supplied or performed in accordance with the applicable purchase order (including any bid/proposal provided, if applicable) or agreement and such Non-Construction Goods and Services quantity and quality must be equal to or better than what is required by such terms. Unless otherwise specified in the applicable agreement, invoices should contain all of the following minimum information in order to be considered a Proper Invoice:

- 1. Name of Vendor
- 2. Remittance address
- 3. Invoice Date

- 4. Invoice number
- 5. The "Bill To" party must be the District or the Board, or other entity approved in writing by the Board of the District Manager
- 6. Project name (if applicable)
- 7. In addition to the information required in Section IV.D.1-6 above, invoices involving the *purchase of goods* should also contain:
 - a. A complete item description
 - b. Quantity purchased
 - c. Unit price(s)
 - d. Total price (for each item)
 - e. Total amount of invoice (all items)
 - f. The location and date(s) of delivery of the goods to the District
- 8. In addition to the information required in Section IV.D.1-6 above, invoices involving the *purchase of services* should also contain:
 - a. Itemized description of services performed
 - b. The location and date of delivery of the services to the District
 - c. Billing method for services performed (i.e., approved hourly rates, percentage of completion, cost plus fixed fee, direct/actual costs, etc.)
 - d. Itemization of other direct, reimbursable costs (including description and amount)
 - e. Copies of invoices for other direct, reimbursable costs (other than incidental costs such as copying) and one (1) of the following:
 - i. Copy of both sides of a cancelled check evidencing payment for costs submitted for reimbursement
 - ii. Paid receipt
 - iii. Waiver/lien release from subcontractor (if applicable)
- 9. Any applicable discounts
- 10. Any other information or documentation, which may be required or specified under the terms of the purchase order or agreement

E. Proper Payment Request Requirements for Construction Services

Payment Requests must conform to all requirements of Section IV, A-D above, unless otherwise specified in the terms of the applicable agreement or purchase order between the District and the Provider.

V. Submission of Invoices and Payment Requests

The Provider shall submit all Invoices and Payment Requests for both Construction Services and Non-Construction Goods and Services to the District's Agent as provided in the purchase order or agreement, as applicable, and to the District Manager as follows:

Submit the invoice and/or payment request, with required additional material and in conformance with these Policies and Procedures, by mail, by hand delivery, or via email (Note: email is the preferred method for receipt of Non-Construction Goods and Services invoices).

VI. Calculation of Payment Due Date

A. Non-Construction Goods and Services Invoices

1. Receipt of Proper Invoice

Payment is due from the District forty-five (45) days from the date on which a Proper Invoice is Date Stamped.

2. Receipt of Improper Invoice

If an Improper Invoice is received, a required invoice is not received, or invoicing of a request for payment is not required, the time when payment is due from the District is forty-five (45) days from the <u>latest</u> date of the following:

- a. On which delivery of personal property is fully accepted by the District;
- b. On which services are completed and accepted by the District;
- c. On which the contracted rental period begins (if applicable); or
- d. On which the District and the Vendor agree in a written agreement that provides payment due dates.

3. Rejection of an Improper Invoice

The District may reject an Improper Invoice. Within ten (10) days of receipt of the Improper Invoice by the District, the Vendor must be notified that the invoice is improper and be given an opportunity to correct the deficient or missing information, remedy the faulty work, replace the defective goods, or take other necessary, remedial action.

The District's rejection of an Improper Invoice must:

- a. Be provided in writing;
- b. Specify any and all known deficiencies; and
- c. State actions necessary to correct the Improper Invoice.

If the Vendor submits a corrected invoice, which corrects the deficiencies specified in the District's written rejection, the District must pay the corrected invoice within the later of: (a) ten (10) business days after date

the corrected invoice is Date Stamped; or (b) forty-five (45) days after the date the Improper Invoice was Date Stamped.

If the Vendor submits an invoice in response to the District's written rejection which fails to correct the deficiencies specified or continues to be an Improper Invoice, the District must reject that invoice as stated herein.

4. Payment of Undisputed Portion of Invoice

If the District disputes a portion of an invoice, the undisputed portion shall be paid in a timely manner and in accordance with the due dates for payment as specified in these Policies & Procedures.

B. Payment Requests for Construction Services

1. Receipt of Proper Payment Request

The time at which payment is due for Construction Services from the District is as follows:

a. If an Agent must approve the payment request before it is submitted to the District Manager, payment (whether full or partial) is due twenty-five (25) business days after the payment request is Date Stamped. The Provider may send the District an overdue notice. If the payment request is not rejected within four (4) business days after Date Stamp of the overdue notice, the payment request shall be deemed accepted, except for any portion of the payment request that is fraudulent, misleading or is the subject of dispute.

The agreement between the District and the Provider shall identify the Agent to which the Provider shall submit its payment request, or shall be provided by the District through a separate written notice no later than ten (10) days after contract award or notice to proceed, whichever is later. Provider's submission of a payment request to the Agent shall be Date Stamped, which shall commence the time periods for payment or rejection of a payment request or invoice as provided in this section.

b. If, pursuant to contract, an Agent is not required to approve the payment request submitted to the District, payment is due twenty (20) business days after the payment request is Date Stamped unless such payment request includes fraudulent or misleading information or is the subject of dispute.

2. Receipt and Rejection of Improper Payment Request

- a. If an Improper Payment Request is received, the District must reject the Improper Payment Request within twenty (20) business days after the date on which the payment request is Date Stamped.
- b. The District's rejection of the Improper Payment Request must:
 - i. Be provided in writing;
 - ii. Specify any and all known deficiencies; and
 - iii. State actions necessary to correct the Improper Invoice.
- c. If a Provider submits a payment request which corrects the deficiency specified in the District's written rejection, the District must pay or reject the corrected submission no later than ten (10) business days after the date the corrected payment request is Date Stamped.

3. Payment of Undisputed Portion of Payment Request

If the District disputes a portion of a payment request, the undisputed portion shall be paid in a timely manner and in accordance with the due dates for payment as specified in this section.

VII. Resolution of Disputes

If a dispute arises between a Provider and the District concerning payment of an invoice or payment request, the dispute shall be resolved as set forth in §218.735, Fla. Stat., for Construction Services, and §218.76, Fla. Stat. for Non-Construction Goods and Services.

A. Dispute between the District and a Provider

If a dispute between the District and a Provider cannot be resolved following resubmission of a payment request by the Provider, the dispute must be resolved in accordance with the dispute resolution procedure prescribed in the construction contract, if any. In the absence of a prescribed procedure in the contract, the dispute must be resolved by the procedures specified below.

B. Dispute Resolution Procedures

1. If an Improper Payment Request or Improper Invoice is submitted, and the Provider refuses or fails to submit a revised payment request or invoice as contemplated by the PPA and these Policies and Procedures, the Provider shall, not later than thirty (30) days after the date on which the last payment request or invoice was Date Stamped, submit a written statement via certified mail to the Agent, copying the District Manager, specifying the basis upon which the Provider contends the last submitted payment request or invoice was proper.

- 2. Within forty-five (45) days of receipt by the Agent and District Manager of the disputed, last-submitted payment request or invoice, the Agent and/or District Manager shall commence investigation of the dispute and render a final decision on the matter no later than sixty (60) days after the date on which the last-submitted payment request or invoice is Date Stamped.
- 3. With regard to contracts executed on or after July 1, 2021, if the District does not commence the dispute resolution procedure within the time provided herein, a Provider may give written notice via certified mail to the Agent, copying the District Manager, of the District's failure to timely commence its dispute resolution procedure. If the District fails to commence the dispute resolution procedure within 4 business days after receipt of such notice, any amounts resolved in the Provider's favor shall bear mandatory interest, as set forth in section 218.735(9), Florida Statutes, from the date on which the payment request or invoice containing the disputed amounts was Date Stamped. If the dispute resolution procedure is not commenced within 4 business days after receipt of the notice, the objection to the payment request or invoice shall be deemed waived. The waiver of an objection pursuant to this paragraph does not relieve a Provider of its contractual obligations.
- 4. Absent a written agreement to the contrary, if the Provider refuses or fails to provide the written statement required above, the Agent and/or District Manager is not required to contact the Provider in the investigation. In addition, and absent a written agreement to the contrary, if such written statement is not provided, the District may immediately contract with third parties to provide the goods and services subject to the dispute and deduct the costs of such third party purchases from amounts owed to the Provider.
- 5. The Board shall approve any decision of the District Manager to contract with a third party which would result in: 1) an expenditure above what is budgeted for the Construction Services or Non-Construction Services; or 2) an expenditure which exceeds the original contract amount for the Construction Services or Non-Construction Services by more than ten percent (10%) or Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000).
- 6. A written explanation of the final decision shall be sent to the Provider, via certified mail, within five (5) business days from the date on which such final decision is made. A copy of the written explanation of the final decision shall be provided to the Chairperson of the Board simultaneously with the certified mailing to the Provider.

7. If a Provider does not accept in writing the final decision within five (5) days after receipt by the Provider, the District may immediately contract with third parties to provide the goods and services subject to the dispute and deduct the costs of such third party purchases from amounts owed to the Provider. If the costs of the third party purchases exceed the amount the District owes to the Provider, the District may seek to recover such excess from the Provider in a court of law or as otherwise provided in an agreement between the District and the Provider. Nothing contained herein shall limit or affect the District's ability to enforce all of its legal and contractual rights and remedies against the Provider.

VIII. Purchases Involving Federal Funds or Bond Funds

When the District intends to pay for a purchase with federal funds or bond funds, the District shall make such purchases only upon reasonable assurances that federal funds or bond funds sufficient to cover the cost will be received. When payment is contingent upon the receipt of bond funds, federal funds or federal approval, the public procurement documents and any agreement with a Provider shall clearly state such contingency. (§218.77, Fla. Stat.).

IX. Requirements for Construction Services Contracts – Project Completion; Retainage

The District intends to follow the PPA requirements for construction project completion and retainage, including, but not limited to, §218.735 (7) and (8), Fla. Stat.

X. Late Payment Interest Charges

Failure on the part of the District to make timely payments may result in District responsibility for late payment interest charges. No agreement between the District and a Provider may prohibit the collection of late payment interest charges allowable under the PPA as mandatory interest. (§218.75, Fla. Stat.).

A. Related to Non-Construction Goods and Services

All payments due from the District, and not made within the time specified within this policy, will bear interest, from thirty (30) days after the due date, at the rate of one percent (1%) per month on the unpaid balance. The Vendor must submit a Proper Invoice to the District for any interest accrued in order to receive the interest payment. (§218.735(9), Fla. Stat.).

An overdue period of less than one (1) month is considered as one (1) month in computing interest. Unpaid interest is compounded monthly. The term one (1) month means a period beginning on any day of a month and ending on the same day of the following month.

B. Related to Construction Services

All payments for Construction Services that are not made within the time periods specified within the applicable statute, shall bear interest from thirty (30) days after the due date, at the rate of one percent (1%) per month for contracts executed on or before June 30, 2021, and at the rate of two percent (2%) per month for contracts executed on or after July 1, 2021, or the rate specified by agreement, whichever is greater. §218.735(9), Fla. Stat. The Provider must submit a Proper Payment Request to the District for any interest accrued in order to receive the interest payment. An overdue period of less than one (1) month is considered as one (1) month in computing interest. (§218.74 (4), Fla. Stat.).

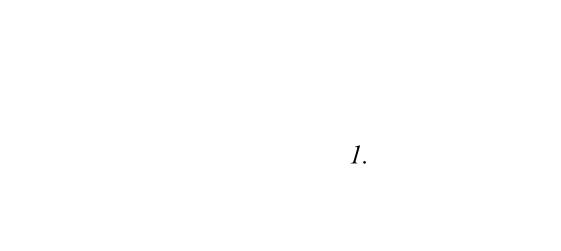
Unpaid interest is compounded monthly. The term one (1) month means a period beginning on any day of a month and ending on the same day of the following month.

C. **Report of Interest**

If the total amount of interest paid during the preceding fiscal year exceeds \$250, the District Manager is required to submit a report to the Board during December of each year, stating the number of interest payments made and the total amount of such payments. (§218.78, Fla. Stat.).

- c. Winter maintenance projects and cleaning will begin in January focusing on Spring Break opening in a few short months.

2. Athletic Center

- a. FCC is nearing completion on both balconies. East side waterproofing is complete and will be finishing final paint on column bands. West side stucco is being finished and will need painted and waterproofing completion.
- b. Received new bottle fill stations to retrofit existing drinking fountains on the patios once FCC is done with the balcony project.
 - c. Angel Tree was another success this year thank you to the residents and staff who participated!

Golf and Clubhouse Operations:

Golf Operations

- a. A busy month of December. We played 4400 rounds.
- b. Weekly member groups had a good turnout in December with 1100 member rounds.
- c. Range sales totaled \$3300 in November, with over 700 users.
- d. A great month of sales in the golf shop in December. Sales totaling \$25,000
- e. The Community hosted the Annual 12 holes of Christmas Event.

Clubhouse F&B

- a. December was a solid month operationally as well as financially.
- b. Golf had a few tournaments, driving Food and Beverage sales, including our largest tournament (Construction Career Days)
- c. We conducted very successful internal events, including Breakfast with Santa, The Holiday Mixer, and the Soaring Eagles Christmas Dinner.
- d. The outlook for outside events appear strong through the beginning of the year.
- e. Price and supply challenges continue, and may worsen with the new variant,
- f. Staffing has been stable with our seasonal staff supporting us during the holidays. Challenges continue with staff through scheduling, availability, and apparent lack of necessity to work.
- g. We are planning for a renewal of monthly events beginning in the first quarter of the year, focused on more resident experiences up at the clubhouse.

Golf Course Maintenance

- 1. Greens were spiked to relieve compaction.
- 2. We applied our monthly wetting agent application to increase water infiltration and increase firmness.
- 3. Maccurrach Golf began installing curbing, added a pad for the driving range mats, and has regressed areas of the driving range. Work should be completed by mid January.
- 4. We completed installing landscape edging around the tee signs and freshening up the stone, ongoing
- 5. Continuing edging cat paths using new Ventrac tractor.
- 6. We are continuing to spot spray weeds as they emerge, ongoing process.
- 7. Fairways and tees were sprayed with pigment to provide a greener playing surface as we approach dormancy.
- 8. The overseeded turf was fertilized.
- 9. The area along cart paths were aerified and fertilized to combat wear. We received our aerifier attachment for the Ventrac tractor.
- 10. 2.9" inches of rain for the month of December to date

Common Areas & Retention Ponds:

- 1. All lakes have been treated and inspected by the Lake Doctors. Written reports are submitted after each treatment. The Lake doctors continue to be responsive to our requests for additional treatments and adding dye where beneficial. Cooler weather has assisted in health of the ponds.
- 2. The waterfall vault has not changed and the suction baskets are cleaned about once a month now.
- 3. M&J pedestrian is scheduled for January 18th to paint crosswalks and repaint cart crossings.
- 4. Bloodworth Asphalt completed golf cart parking striping. Removable bollards to be installed by staff.
- 5. Ordered an additional 5 pet waste sections for amenity area, phase 5/6 and on Club Lake by Grey Hawk.

Landscaping:

1. Director of Operations confers with Tree Amigos Landscape on a weekly basis. Grounds are being maintained per the contract.

- 2. Maintenance services provided to Eagle Landing by Tree Amigos December 1st thru December 31st
 - a. Ongoing maintenance per schedule for mowing and detail operations.
 - b. December irrigation inspection and repairs completed the week of 12/13/21. The irrigation system has been set to run everything 3 days a week and the flowers every other day. The system is readjusted weekly if needed
 - c. Second application of Milestone was applied on vines across from Clubhouse along Parkway second week of December.
 - d. Brown patch was re-treated on all St. Augustine turf areas.
 - e. Hanging Baskets and big planters were completed by 1st week of December.
 - f. Flowers were replaced in all beds on 12/15/21.
 - g. Island in Amenity Pond detailed 1st week of December

Misc:

- 1. Answered numerous phone calls, emails and visits from residents, contractors, vendors and other persons with inquiries. The subjects included, golf course maintenance, easement encroachments, alligators, lake maintenance, directions, repairs, drainage (both County and CDD owned), dead trees, vandalism, security, etc
 - 2. Facilities are inspected on a weekly basis
 - 3. The parks and playgrounds are inspected weekly and required repairs are made.
 - 4. Daily trash pickup along parkway, park sites and common areas.
 - 5. Amenity and common area cameras reviewed frequently; recordings provided to CCSO.
