#### FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS Roll Call

Ms. Giles called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. and called the roll.

#### SECOND ORDER OF BUSINESS Audience Comments

There being none, the next item followed.

# THIRD ORDER OF BUSINESS Approval of the Minutes of the September 5, 2023 Meeting

On MOTION by Mr. Payton seconded by Mr. Brink with all in favor the minutes of the September 5, 2023 meeting were approved as presented. October 3, 2023 South Village CDD

#### FOURTH ORDER OF BUSINESS Discussion of Fiscal Year 2023 Bonus Policy

Ms. Giles stated on the table are the board rankings of Honours Golf Performance for award of the FY23 bonus per the evaluation criteria, with a bonus amount of \$5,499.

On MOTION by Mr. Payton seconded by Mr. Brink with all in favor the bonus amount of \$5,499 was approved.

Ms. Giles stated this is the board's opportunity to discuss improvements or changes to the evaluation criteria going forward.

Mr. Payton stated we previously talked about the evaluation criteria being out of date and vague. I submitted a draft of a new score card and we can discuss it next month after everyone has an opportunity to review it. I added definitions and metrics for each item.

#### FIFTH ORDER OF BUSINESS Discussion of Suspension Letters

Ms. Buchanan stated because this involves a minor we don't refer to the individual by name.

Mr. Biagetti stated there was an incident that occurred in the basketball court area two individuals were key to this and the sheriff's office was involved as well. One individual is a resident and one is not and the non-resident is trespassing on the facility and we have an interim suspension of the resident until this board meeting.

A resident stated we are the parents of one the minors involved. We don't condone his actions; he understands where he made a mistake in his actions. Going forward he will not be involved in any violence or heated discussions. The other minor was arrested for violence with other minors. We had other incidents where our son's bicycle was stolen from the office here; that person returned it and we agreed not to press charges. The second time it was stolen from inside the gym next to the front office. All three incidents were with people from outside the community.

A resident stated whoever brought the non-resident in should be responsible for that person.

Mr. Davidson stated based on previous history and we try to be fair and not show any favoritism there has been a minimum 6-month suspension for fighting for the aggressor. One time we did a three-month suspension based on nothing led up to the other kid attacking the other kid.

After discussion the board took the following action.

#### 4. Tennis/Pickleball

a. Pickleball court renovation will begin in November closing our current courts for roughly two weeks.

- b. League teams are in full swing.
- c. Tennis Social is scheduled for November 1st!
- d. Pickleball Grand Opening Social will be scheduled after opening of the newly renovated courts!

#### **Golf and Clubhouse Operations:**

#### **Golf Operations**

- a. A good weather month in October. We played 4400 rounds.
- b. Weekly member groups had a lower turnout in October with 1200 member rounds.
- c. Range sales totaled \$2800 in October, with 675 users.
- d. A good month of sales in the golf shop in October. Sales totaling \$19,500
- e. We held the third annual Eagle Landing Member Guest. We hosted 30 members and their guest for 3 days of golf, f&b, and competition. Member Robert Forde and his guest Michael Forde won the competition.

#### Clubhouse F&B

- a. Solid sales exceeding the budget, positive results came back in September as well being in the black
- b. The Golf tournaments were strong with 4 awesome tournaments along with the Member Guest, with great positive feedback from all. The Bingo night we host for Caldwell Banker was packed as usual. We also conducted a Soaring Eagles ladies luncheon, and a Florida Georgia watch party, followed by live music and a Halloween themed party
- c. Taco Tuesdays has had a positive impact, which will continue at least twice per month going forward through the holidays, sprinkled in with other events. We added live music, which will also continue a couple times a month as well. Feedback from that has been awesome. Thursday Night football and Sunday Football has been solid. We will continue to add "profitable" sales builders as we move through the year.
- d. Prices are high but stable, and we will be adjusting specials, and menu offerings with the new menu due out within the next 60 days.
- e. We continue to struggle with operational challenges in the back of the house. The core group is solid but the support staff is a challenge with skill level and work ethics seemingly at an all-time low. Service staff levels are at par, but school schedules and outside interests take precedence with this generation of hospitality workers.

#### Golf Course Maintenance

- 1. Wall to wall fertility and pre-emergent applications, excluding overseed areas.
- 2. Two wetting agent applications for firmness and water infiltration.
- 3. Three vertical mowings for continued thatch dilution.
- 4. Three light topdressings to aid in greens firmness.
- 5. Drainage added to number 4 bunker (others will follow suit).

#### **Common Areas & Retention Ponds:**

- 1. All lakes have been treated and inspected by the Lake Doctors. There have been a few ponds needing retreated but overall in good health.
- 2. Camera additions and upgrades in progress.
- 3. Off-duty CCSO deputies have been hired for Halloween Trick-or-Treat traffic flow and additional Viewpoint Security Officers to monitor parking lots and buildings.
- 4. Auction of golf excess/old golf maintenance equipment has closed and items are being hauled away.

#### **Landscaping:**

- 1. Director of Operations confers with Tree Amigos Landscape on a weekly basis. Grounds are being maintained per the contract.
  - a. Maintenance services provided to Eagle Landing by Tree Amigos October 1<sup>st</sup> thru October 31st 2023.
  - b. Ongoing maintenance per schedule for mowing and detail operations.
  - c. October irrigation inspection and repairs completed the week of 10/16/23. The irrigation system has been set to run everything 4 days a week. The system is readjusted weekly if needed due to weather conditions. Pocket parks and common areas and signs in Neighborhoods run 3 days a week. Flower zones run every other day. The run schedule remains the same. Rain sensors have been tested and are working correctly.
  - d. Mulch has been completed at waterfall at entrance and island in lake.
  - e. Soccer fields were re-treated with herbicide for Sedge Grass again 10/16/23.
  - f. New flowers in beds were replaced and doing well.
  - g. Shrubs around tennis courts scheduled to be cut then maintained at mid bar height.
  - h. Mulch completion at the parks scheduled for week of 10/30/23.
  - i. Yearly cutbacks scheduled to begin week of 10/30/23.

#### Misc:

- 1. Answered numerous phone calls, emails and visits from residents, contractors, vendors and other persons with inquiries. The subjects included, golf course maintenance, easement encroachments, alligators, lake maintenance, directions, repairs, drainage (both County and CDD owned), dead trees, vandalism, security, etc
  - 2. Facilities are inspected on a weekly basis
  - 3. The parks and playgrounds are inspected weekly and required repairs are made.
  - 4. Daily trash pickup along parkway, park sites and common areas.
  - 5. Amenity and common area cameras reviewed frequently; recordings provided to CCSO.

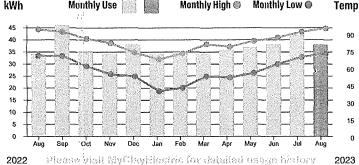

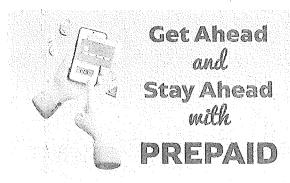

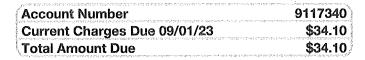

#### **DEFINITIONS:**

Access Charge: The Access Charge recovers some of the fixed costs that come directly from serving an individual member, regardless of how much electricity is used. These costs include the cost of the meter, wire and other equipment used to deliver electricity to the home or business, as well as meter reading technology and billing expenses. All utilities have some type of an access charge.

Power Cost Adjustment: The Power Cost Adjustment reflects the increases/decreases in the co-op's cost of power purchased wholesale from Seminole Electric Cooperative. The fluctuation in the Power Cost Adjustment is largely caused by changes in the cost of fuel for generation.

**Operation Round Up:** Operation Round Up is a program to generate and collect voluntary donations that are used to benefit organizations in Clay Electric's service area for the purpose of improving the quality of life of our members and their communities.

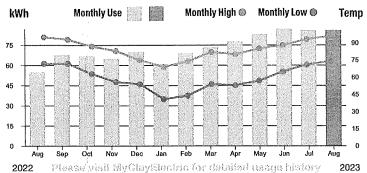

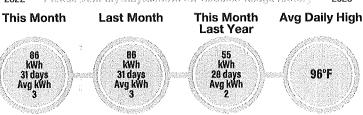

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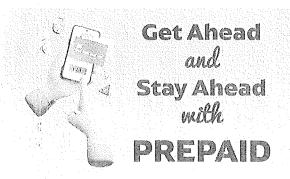
